NOTICE TO BUYERS - TERMS OF SALE CASH - ALL PURCHASES TO BE SETTLED FOR AND CLEARED ON DAY OF SALE. PURCHASE NOTES AND DELIVERY ORDERS WILL BE OBTAINED FROM THE SALE CASHIER WHEN THE LOTS ARE SETTLED FOR AND, ON HANDING DELIVERY ORDER TO SHEPHERDS IN CHARGE THEY WILL GIVE DELIVERY AND ASSIST IN TRUCKING. THE CORRECT NUMBERS OF EACH LOT WILL BE GIVEN AT THE TIME OF SALE. WHEN LOTS REQUIRE TO BE CUT THE AUCTIONEERS RESERVE THE RIGHT TO SEND THEIR YARD SHEPHERD TO DO SO. PAYMENT WILL ONLY BE TAKEN IN CASH OR CHEQUES VOUCHERED BY BANKERS' LETTERS. DISPUTED STURDY SHEEP SHALL BE DECIDED BY THE YARD SHEPHERD. EVERY ASSISTANCE IN TRUCKING WILL BE ARRANGED, AS FAR AS POSSIBLE, BY THE AUCTIONEERS WHO WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR LOSS OR DAMAGE INCURRED THEREBY. FULL TRUCKING INSTRUCTIONS INCLUDING POSTAL ADDRESS MUST BE LEFT IN WRITING WITH THE OFFICE.
